

NCWSA CLUB CHAMPIONS

NCWSA Club Champion Requirements and Eligibility

To be eligible to compete for the club champions trophy the competing clubs shall meet the following requirements:

- Each club must have a physical presence within the borders of the state of North Carolina.
- Each club shall be a paid member of the NCWSA prior to holding a tournament or by the NC State Championships.
- Each member of club competing will be a paid NCWSA and AWSA member prior to or at the first tournament they compete in.
- Members of clubs competing for club champion trophy do not have to be resident of North Carolina but must meet and follow all individual and club requirements and rules. This rule is not to be confused with the individual requirements to compete for individual titles in the NC Water Ski Championships.
- Each club must submit their NCWSA affiliated members prior to first NC AWSA sanctioned tournament. A new skiing member meeting eligibility may be added at each NC tournament at which they compete prior to the NC Championships. Member additions will not be allowed at the NC Championships.
- If any questions or controversy arises regarding club and member eligibility the NC State AWSA Council will make any ruling regarding such matters.
- Any such questions or controversy should be presented to the NCWSA President for ruling.

NCWSA Club Champion Scoring and Participation Point System

The winning club champion will be determined by qualified members, as described under requirements and eligibility, participation in North Carolina AWSA sanctioned tournaments. Following is the purposed point system.

- Every eligible member of an eligible club will be awarded points for every NCWSA AWSA sanction tournament they ski in North Carolina.
- Points will only be awarded for AWSA sanctioned tournaments held by NCWSA affiliated clubs in the state of North Carolina. There will be no exceptions.
- Points will be awarded for each club member as indicated below:
2-Points awarded for skiing in a NC tournament.
1-Point for each event skied in that tournament. (Ex=A three event skier would receive 5 point)
Additional points will be awarded for placement in all NC tournaments as follows:
3 points for 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place, 1 point for 3rd place
- Points will be awarded for tournament held from State Championships through State Championships the following year.*
- The Club with the most participation points will be declared the NCWSA Club Champions.
- The trophy will be awarded at the annual NC State Championships.
- If any questions or controversy arises regarding club and member eligibility the NC State AWSA Council will make any ruling regarding such matters.
- Any such questions or controversy should be presented to the NCWSA President for ruling.

* The 2010 season will start after the 2009 Championships through 2010 Championships.
