- c. State Tournament 2020 Ari Grode
  - i. Order of events: would like to do ALL slalom on Saturday, trick/jump on Sunday
    - 1. Pros
      - a. Ease of course changes
      - b. Time
    - 2. Cons
      - a. Decrease in banquet attendees
      - b. Officials may not wan to stay the following day
      - c. Junior awards at banquet
  - ii. Please contact Ari Grode for any suggestions for State tournament
- d. Tournament Dates Jeff Gilbert
  - i. Tournament Cancellations
    - 1. Bylaws states you must cancel 30 days prior to event unless there is an extenuating circumstance
    - 2. Need to notify all other local tournament directors ASAP
    - 3. Need to notify Tommy Harrington so he can post update online
  - ii. Discussed possible exclusions for the rule of tournament date protection.
    - Thought that tournaments such as Big Dawg, Queen's Cup are different type/caliber tournaments and should be excluded from the rule
    - 2. Discussed that Big Dawg is possibly excluded however Queen's Cup is still considered a local tournament
    - 3. No changes to current rule have been made
  - iii. COMMUNICATION IS KEY
    - Additional tournament dates any open weekend is 1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> served basis; no need to have approval if it is open
      - a. If you are even considering an additional tournament date, contact all other local clubs as a courtesy
      - b. Contact AWSA site ASAP for them to post
      - c. If you would like to host a tournament on a date that is already taken, contact that tournament director ASAP to see if it can be worked out for both officials and skiers
        - i. The rule is written as to not put pressure on officials, drivers, and skiers to have to choose. Keep this in mind and be respectful.
    - 2. COMMUNICATION IS KEY!!!!!
